Nevertheless, the little girl brought the gift box to her mother the next morning. "This is for you, Momma," she said, handing over the gift with great pride and joy.

The mother was embarrassed by her earlier over-reaction, but her anger flared again when she opened the box and found it empty. She once again spoke harshly to her daughter. "Don't you know, young lady, that when you give someone a present, there's supposed to be something inside the package?"

The little girl had tears in her eyes as she said, "Oh, Momma, it's not empty! I blew kisses into it until it was full."

The mother was crushed. She knelt down and put her arms around her little girl and begged her forgiveness for her thoughtless anger.

An accident took the life of the child only a short time later, and it is told that the mother kept that gold box by her bed for all the years of her life. Whenever she was discouraged or faced difficult problems, she would open the box and take out an imaginary kiss, remembering the love of the child who had put it there.
